CAMBRIDGE ART ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND

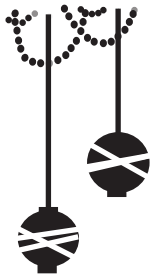
With over 400 artist members living and working in New England, the Cambridge Art Association works to ensure artists can become, and remain members of the CAA regardless of financial status. In this spirit of economic equality, the Cambridge Art Association has offered, for many years, a Scholarship Fund.

This program allows artists who might otherwise be unable to join the organization to participate as full artist members.

Starting this year, an artist member scholarship will cover the cost of membership dues (\$85 per year), as well as the cost of entry into members' juried and non-juried shows (\$10-20 per show).

In 2013, the Cambridge Art Association will also reach into the community through our Scholarship Fund, providing scholarship money to a Cambridge Public School student matriculating in a visual arts program at the college level. Through this outreach we hope to inspire a future generation of art creators.

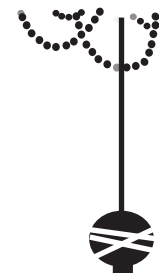
